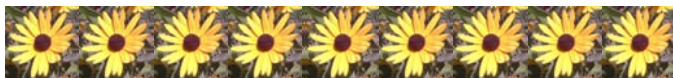
### Please Note

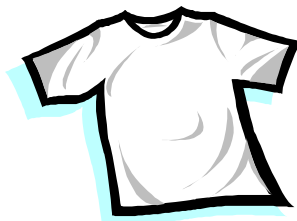
## Fireworks Scheduled for July 3rd at Sawmill Creek Park
