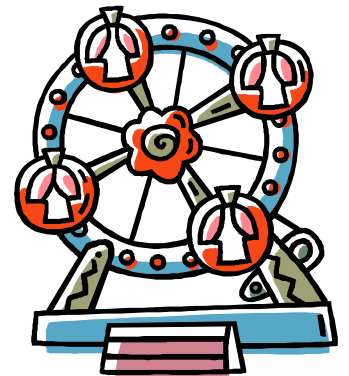
The Big Glen Burnie Carnival is Coming to Town Friday, July 28th-Saturday, August 5th, (Closed on Sunday)

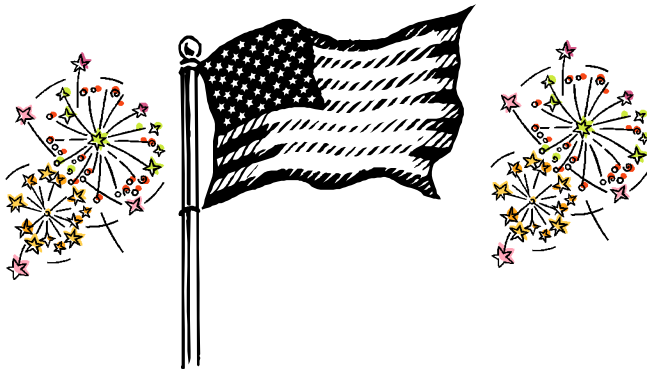
