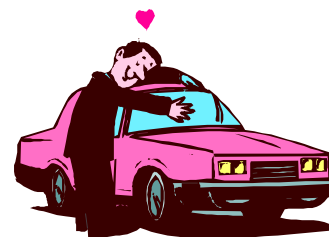
There will once again be games of chance, games requiring a keen eye or steady hand, kiddie games, and back by popular demand,
