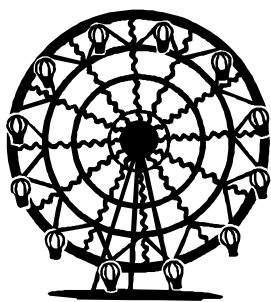

## **New Resolution**

The Board of Directors at the regular meeting held on April 28, 2009, with a quorum being present, discussed issues relating to the replacement of the Flag Pole at Logo Park. That as a result of the discussion, certain resolutions were made, seconded, and passed by a majority vote of the directors to be recommended to the members for adoption after notice. The GBIA board recommends that the Association construct and maintain the Flag Pole at Logo Park pursuant to a proposed license agreement with Anne Arundel County. That the costs of this Association project are not included in the annual budget therefore;

***It is hereby resolved, that the Association shall fund the replacement of the Flag Pole and construction from its' savings in the amount of \$12,028.90. Any contributions from others will be used to repay the Association for its' funds which are expected for this project.***

The Resolution will lay on the table and be discussed and voted on by the general membership at the June 9th meeting.
