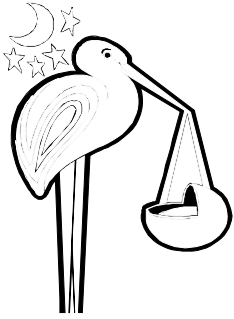
The GBIA Memorial Day Parade will take place on Sunday, May 17th at 2:00 p.m.

BWMC in partnership with Anne Arundel County Department of Health and the March of Dimes has created this program with the goals of healthy pregnancy and

to give your baby a healthy beginning by preventing premature births, low birth weight babies, and decreasing infant mortality.

Using a point based incentive system, the women are encouraged to attend eight (8) Stork's Nest educational classes, keep regular prenatal care appointments, adopt healthy behaviors, take baby to well baby check-ups, and making sure the child receives all of his/her immunizations.

Doing all this will earn the women points towards infant clothing, infant care supplies, car seats, carriers, and other miscellaneous items from the Stork's Nest until the baby is one year old.

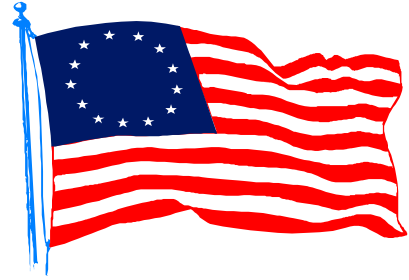
