**Addendum to Proposed Bylaws
Mailed to Members in
September 2005**

Please note this additional change to the proposed changes to the GBIA Bylaws:

Current Amendment:

ARTICLE XV-Amendments
Section 2

The Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws may be amended by a vote of two-thirds(2/3) of the members present at any regular meeting of the Association, provided that written notice of the proposed change in the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws is mailed to members not later than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of said meeting.

Proposed Amendment:

ARTICLE XV-Amendments
Section 2

The Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws may be amended by a majority vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present, provided that they are eligible to cast a vote according to the stipulations outlined in Article IX, Section 2; provided that written notice of the proposed change in the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws is mailed to members not later than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of said meeting.

Voting on these proposed changes to the Bylaws and Amendments will be held on November 8th.

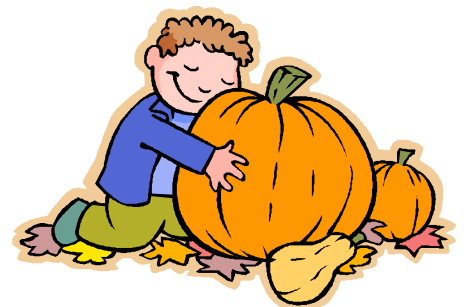


**Informative Speaker Describes
Impending Medicare Changes**

Susan Knight of the Anne Arundel County Department of Aging informed GBIA members at the September General meeting that the biggest changes to Medicare since 1965 are coming soon. These changes, termed Medicare Part D, will include a prescription drug plan for seniors, and will be advertised during the month of October. Sign up for the program will begin November 15th, and the plan will begin in January of 2006. The plan is not for everyone. To help you discern this important decision your former employer should be sending you a letter before November 15th to let you know whether your coverage through them is better than what Medicare D could offer you. If you missed the meeting last month, or are still confused, Susan Knight will be giving an encore performance at the **Pascal Senior Center on Thursday, October 27th at 1:00**. 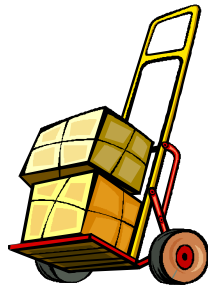
