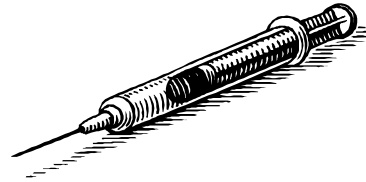
NCEON Needs Your Help
