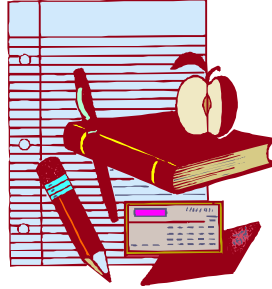

## **September's Guest Speaker**

Mr. Tom Umberger from the Glen Burnie Volunteer Fire Department spoke at the General Membership Meeting about the **Automatic External Defibrillator** that is available at the Glen Burnie Improvement Association. The defibrillator along with CPR has a 92% survival rate. The defibrillator is only used when the heart stops, the person stops breathing, and there is no pulse. This device shocks the heart back into normal rhythm.

Training classes for CPR and the Automatic External Defibrillator are available on October 21st and 28th, then on November 11th & 18th at the Glen Burnie Volunteer Firehouse on Central Avenue. There will also be classes available January thru June 2010. The 2 day classes are FREE (but donations are accepted), and are from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

## **The GBIA Needs You**

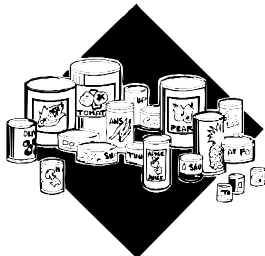
The Membership Committee of the GBIA needs your help and support in order to keep our organization growing and strong.
