DATE: May 23, 2010
WHERE: All Units will assemble at Corkran Middle School on Quarterfield Road.
TIME: Lineup starts at 12:30 p.m., **do not report prior to this time.** Units will move out promptly at 2:00 p.m.

ROUTE: Quarterfield Road / Crain Highway (Business Route 3), north on Crain Highway to Post 40 Road. Right on Post 40 Road. **Vehicles should proceed to the Courthouse Parking Lot and marchers to the carnival grounds for disbursement to keep the parade moving.**

WHO: Everyone is welcome.
Plaques will be awarded in the following categories: Antique and Contemporary Fire Equipment, Antique Vehicles, Veterans, Bands, Equestrian, Youth, Marching Units, Clowns and Floats. Plaques will be mailed to the winners.

There is no entrance fee for the parade, but registration is required. This will ensure you a number in the lineup. You will be informed of your lineup position (red, white or blue group) and your scheduled arrival time prior to parade day. The cut-off date for registration is May 1, 2010. **Those who do not register will be placed at the end of the parade lineup and will not be eligible for awards.**

Each registered unit leader is encouraged to report to the Parade Marshal in charge of either the Red, White or Blue segment upon their arrival at the designated assembly area. This will help alleviate confusion and ensure the prompt start of the parade.

All questions should be directed to the Parade Marshal, and his/her instructions must be followed. The Parade Marshal's word is final as to the unit's position in the Parade. Any violation of this rule may cause the unit to be disqualified.

For safety purposes, **units will not be allowed to throw candy, gifts or promotional materials to the crowd.** Units may walk the materials over to the crowd on the side of the road, but may not throw any objects into the crowd.

To ensure continued movement along the parade route, participants may not stop to perform. **Any unit that stops and demonstrates in front of the Judges' Stand will be disqualified from winning an award.**

Antique Cars and Fire Equipment will be judged on the carnival grounds.
