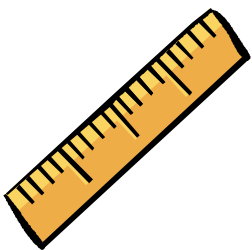
School Supplies Needed

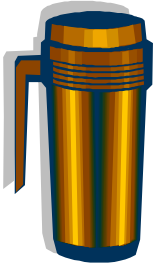
