Dedication Continues with The Big Glen Burnie Carnival

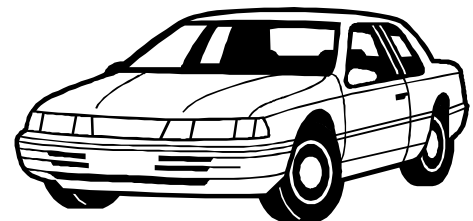

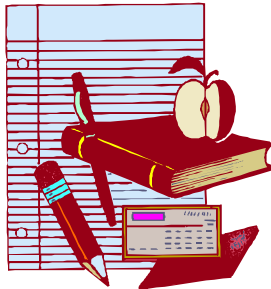
